Concession

For those of you that are new to ECM, we have a very extension concession and hot lunch program that contributes significantly to our fundraising efforts as well as ensures our students are fed healthy meals. As we go into our 2nd year running the online ordering program, our hot lunch administrator has created a comprehensive guide for registering and how the program works. Please read it thoroughly as there are some significant changes to the policies.

Due to the success of the program, we will no longer waste paper to send home order forms to all the students. If you require paper order forms, there will always be a stack of them available at the PAC bulletin board in the school lobby as of the 13th of each month.

Volunteers are needed immediately for the following areas:

Chili making: Once a month for approximately 4 hours to make chili in the school kitchen. Please advise if you have Foodsafe. Please check with Tanya Konings at CMPAC@live.com if you'd like to get Foodsafe certified.

Recycling: Once per week to pick up bags of recyclable bottles and juice boxes to be returned to the recycle depot for redemption. We prefer to have 2 volunteers to alternate.

Groceries: Go shopping once per week, sometimes per month as supplies are needed.

Concession: You are needed to work in concession for approximately 4 hours in the morning through lunch to prepare and distribute food. This is usually a once per week shift. You work in pairs.
