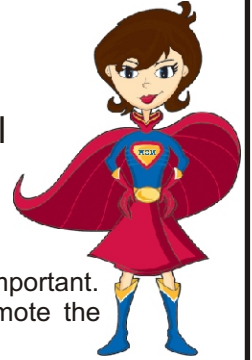

Recycling Competition

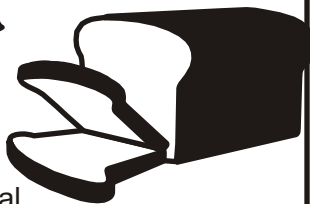

Bottle Drive point system;

Please remember that your bag must be full to receive full points

grocery bag	5points
garbage bag/blue bag	30points
pop case (12)	10points
beercase (12)	10points
beercase (18)	15points
beercase (24)	20points

15 BONUS POINTS will be handed out for bagged containers that arrive counted/sorted (staple a piece of paper to bag with a list of containers and the count)

50 BONUS POINTS for anyone who takes their own bottles to the bottle depot.
